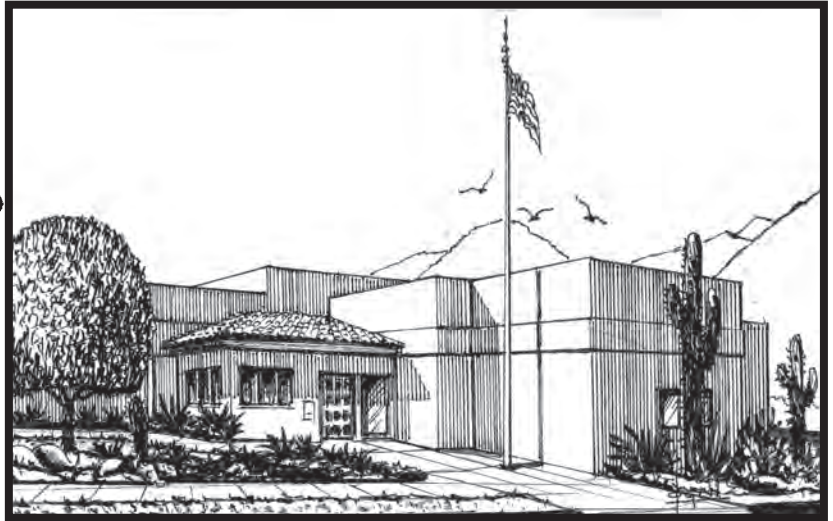

**Assistance available for needy Members**

Needy Elks Members can qualify for up to \$1,000 in an emergency 50-50 matching grant from the Order under Section 5.070 of the Grand Lodge Statues.

The assistance is available to "worthy and needy Members of the Order who are suffering from diseases of an incurable character or from total disability, and who are without funds or property or relatives able or willing to care for them," the Statue states.

The Statute also provides that the Lodge of the assisted Member "shall contribute toward the relief of the Member an amount not less than one-half of the sum that is contributed by the Order."

The assistance program is administered by the Board of Grand Trustees, which is authorized to appropriate up to \$10,000 annually for the program. The board, by resolution, may give the Grand Exalted Ruler up to \$1,000 so that authorized payments may be made regularly by him.

The statue states: "The monies so appropriated shall be administered by the Grand Exalted Ruler with the consent of a majority of the Board of Grand Turstees," .

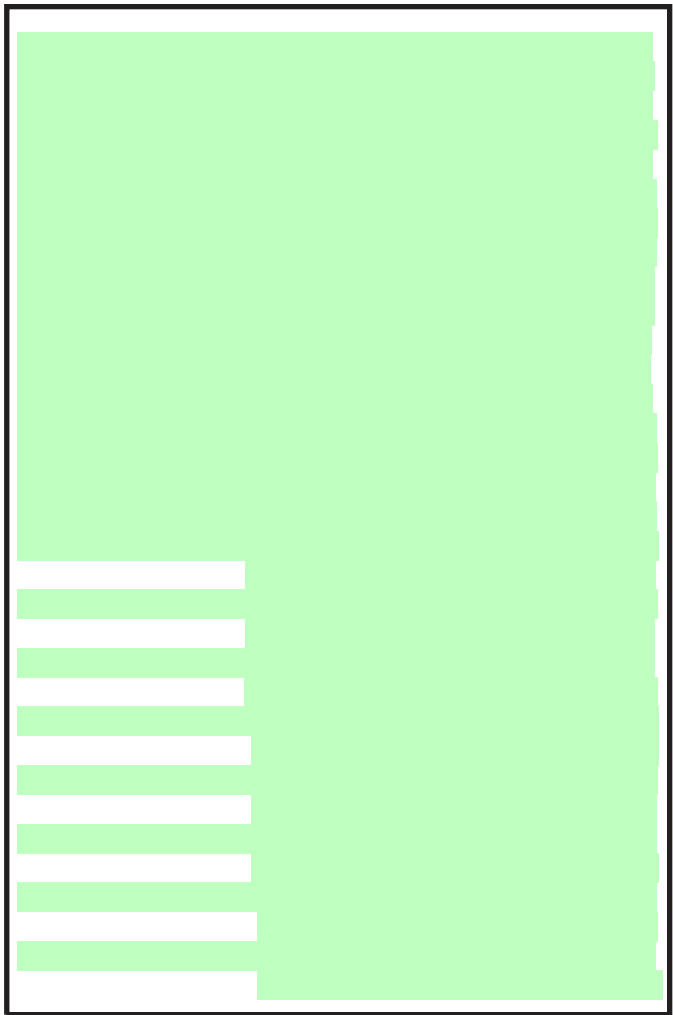
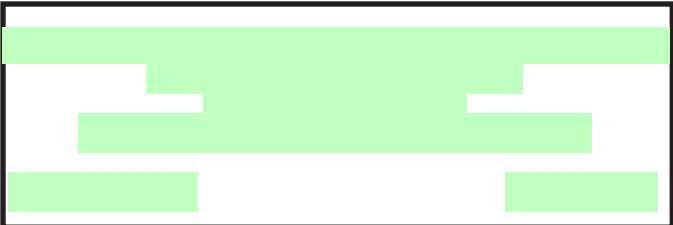
