Handy Man/Woman


We need someone who has experience in the building trades and or building maintenance experience. Especially helpful is licensed electrical or plumbing experience.

Our Lodge was built in multiple stages, beginning in 1983 (main building), with additions in 1993 (dining room), 2003 (lounge) and 2007 (offices and walk in coolers).

Our Lodge is beginning to show it's age as maintenance costs have increased substantially due to deferred maintenance and equipment nearing it's expected life expectancy.

As the building continues to age and needs additional maintenance and repairs it will impact our ability to continue with our charitable work in our community.


What are the benefits?


